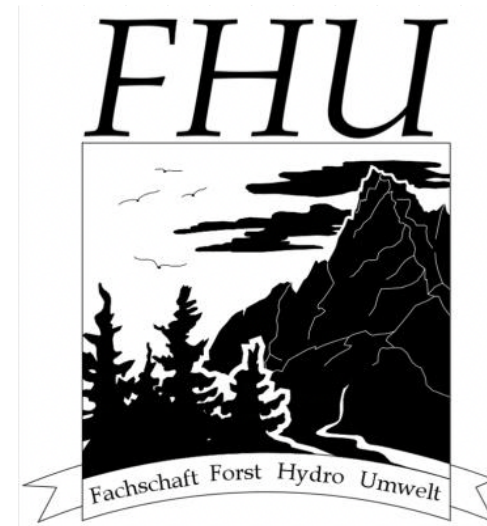

## Health and safety instructions

- always **confirm your attendance** with a member of the student's council before every event
- bring the **signed and filled form** with your contact details to our first meeting
- bring a **certificate of vaccination/recovery/negative test** to every meeting (best in CovPass App)
- negative tests need to be **renewed every day** (we cannot accept test from the day before)
- if you happen to be **tested positively for COVID-19, please tell us immediately!**

By registering for the orientation week, you confirm that you have read those instructions carefully and you accept to comply with them.
